Greetings from Giles

Hello, I am Giles Lindley and I am your interim pastor for the next three months. I go by Giles and will answer to most anything. No one calls me Dr. Lindley except on the MSU campus (although you can use it if you need to impress your Baptist or Presbyterian friends). I have a long tradition of the children and youth calling me Bro. Giles.

I am going to tell much of my spiritual biography in my first sermon with you, but here are some of the more ordinary facts. I grew up in Jackson, though my Dad grew up in Starkville. I graduated MSU with a degree in Philosophy and Religion. I have a Master of Divinity from Duke. I also have MS and PhD degrees in Communication from USM. My dissertation was on the nonverbal messages found in the ways we build and decorate our church sanctuaries,

I grew up in Christ UMC (sadly, no longer a UMC) in Jackson. I have been an ordained member of the Mississippi Annual Conference of the UMC since 1981. Besides field work and youth ministry while at school in North Carolina, I have served under appointment at Philadelphia First (Associate Pastor), Laurel Kingston, d'Iberville Heritage, Ellisville, and New Albany UMCs. After New Albany, I served five years as the East Jackson District Superintendent. For one year, I also covered the Starkville District and visited West Point FUMC for the first time.

After superintending, I served as senior pastor of Starkville FUMC. While at Starkville, I started teaching part-time in the Communication Department at MSU. Upon retiring from full-time ministry in 2018, I began teaching more classes at MSU and usually teach 3-5 sections a semester.

I had taken this spring semester off from MSU to travel, which is why I will be away from April 3-9. I told the Bishop about this planned trip when she called last week, but she remained pretty insistent that I was the person to fill this interim. So, I will.I look forward to seeing you soon and will finish this short bio next week.

Deposits for trip are due by April 5th - \$80 per person.


